



# VERONICA FERRARO

VERONICA FERRARO is a leading mixer, producer and engineer based in Paris, France, whose burgeoning international career is boasted by her 2010 Grammy nomination, an array of chart topping singles, and several platinum and gold albums. Within her 20 years of experience, Ferraro has harnessed and developed her talents by working with top artists from around the world in genres ranging from Dance, to Hip Hop, to Jazz and Folk.

FERRARO is best known for her work mixing the Grammy Nominated Single “**When Love Takes Over**” by French DJ, **David Guetta** featuring vocals by American singer and founding member of Destiny’s Child, **Kelly Rowland**. The crossover hit single charted #1 in 17 countries including the UK and sold over 1.5 million downloads worldwide.

Leading up to her breakthrough international successes, FERRARO has worked with many distinguished French and American artists. She mixed **Sherfya Luna’s** (winner of French TV show Pop Star) double platinum album, contributing two other #1 singles, as well as mixed a gold album for **Mathieu Edward**, a finalist for the French TV show Star Academy.

Remarkably, she mixed the French electro version of “**Chercher Le Garçon**” for **Quentin Mosimann** which reached #1. She recorded and mixed a French featured version of “It Doesn’t Matter” with the talented and profound artist **Wyclef Jean**. A year later, she co-produced three tracks for Grammy Award Winning Rock Singer, **Alannah Myles**, featuring an electro and acoustic version of her famous “Black Velvet” single. More recently she has mixed 4 songs for American folk singer **Beth Hirsch**, well known for her featured vocals on Air’s critically-acclaimed album Moon Safari.

FERRARO continues to mix, produce and engineer in her studio in France in collaboration with Stealth Entertainment on various international projects.
